Special Council Meeting
Thursday, August 11, 2011

Present for Roll Call: Bausano, Fish, Junot, Lanctot and Ninko.

Absent: Harju and Miller.

Guests: Edward Sever and Edward Vertin.

The meeting was called to order in the village council chambers by President Bausano at 5:15PM.

At the July 19, 2011 regular council meeting, the council voted to pursue purchasing the foreclosed property at 82 First Street. The intention was to demolish the house on the property and use the lot as a snow dump. The minimum bid for purchasing the property was \$3030.46. An estimate of about \$15,000 was given to demolish the house. Due to the age of the house, asbestos abatement and lead paint removal would also be necessary at additional costs. A motion was made by Lanctot and seconded by Junot to not exercise the village's right to purchase the foreclosed property at 82 First Street due to the excessive cost involved in demolishing the house. Carried 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 5:20PM.
