

Village of Laurium

Ordinance Number 151

The Village of Laurium Ordains:

An ordinance establishing rules and regulations on removal of feces of dogs and other pets

1. The owner, and any other person having control of, a dog or other pet that defecates on any public property (sidewalks, streets, parks, recreation areas) or on any private property other than property owned by the owner of said pet, shall immediately remove such dog's or other pet's feces from such public or private property.
2. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a municipal civil infraction. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be fined One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the first violation and Two Hundred (\$200.00) for each subsequent violation.
3. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Laurium Village Police Department.

This ordinance was enacted by the Village Council, Laurium, Houghton County,
Michigan

on the 16th day of October, 2012.

This ordinance shall take effect 20 days from the date of adoption.

Effective the 5th day of November, 2012.


