## **ORDINANCE #153 PROHIBITED FARM AND LIVESTOCK ANIMALS IN VILLAGE LIMITS**

An Ordinance prohibiting the keeping or maintaining of chickens, ducks, geese, waterfowl and livestock within the Village of Laurium, making the violation of this Ordinance a municipal civil infraction and establishing the civil fines for violations of this Ordinance.

The Village of Laurium hereby ordains:

- 1) No person shall at any time raise, house, keep or allow to remain on any property (including within any building(s)) within the Village of Laurium any live or unprocessed chickens(s), duck(s), geese, waterfowl or livestock.
- 2) Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a Village Civil Infraction punishable by a civil fine of \$100.00 per offense and \$200.00 for any subsequent offense occurring within 90 days of a prior offense.
- 3) Each day that a violation of this Ordinance occurs or continues shall be deemed to constitute a separate Village civil infraction for which a separate Village Civil Infraction Violation Notice and/or Village Civil Infraction Citation may be issued and for which the above civil fine(s) may be levied.
- 4) The effective date of this Ordinance shall be September 11, 2017
