

Village of Laurium  
Special Council Meeting  
Monday, December 5, 2022

**Present for Roll Call:** Erickson, Galbraith, Hrebec (online) and Sullivan.

**Absent:** Carlson and Jenich-Laplander.

**Guest:** Unidentified person online.

The meeting was called to order in the village council chambers by President Sullivan at 6:10PM.

The Sno-Go repair work was added to the agenda.

The **village manager** candidate was offered a contract. He counter offered with a request for 3 weeks' vacation years 1-6, years 7 and beyond, 4 weeks and 3 personal days that do not count against sick time. After a lengthy discussion, it was decided we would offer 12 sick/personal days and 2 weeks' vacation for the first year but can use one week of the next year's vacation with council approval.

There currently is not a **budget** in place for the manager position. Thoughts were given as to how to fund this position for January & February 2023. One possibility is the ARPA funds, another is to hold off until March 1, 2023 when the budget for the next fiscal year is in place. The auditor will be asked what our options are and the matter was tabled until the December regular meeting.

The hydraulic pump on the **Sno-Go** needs to be repaired. The cost is \$4000 and the core is \$3000 so the cost to us will be \$1000. A motion was made by Galbraith and seconded by Erickson to purchase the repair part. Carried 4-0.

The meeting adjourned at 7:12PM.
