Monday, August 21, 2017

Present for Roll Call: Bausano, Robert Erickson, Hodges, Junot and Lanctot.

Absent: Jeff Erickson and Miller.

The meeting was called to order in the village council chambers by President Bausano at 5:00PM.

The purpose of the special meeting was to consider an **ordinance** banning chickens, ducks, geese, waterfowl and livestock in the village. Lanctot questioned whether those that already have these animals will be grandfathered into the ordinance. This was not the intent when it was drafted by the village attorney. Residents will have 20 days until the ordinance takes effect to remove their chickens, etc. from the village. A motion was made by Lanctot and seconded by Junot to adopt Ordinance #153 – Prohibiting the keeping or maintaining of chickens, ducks, geese, waterfowl and livestock within the Village of Laurium. Carried 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 5:05PM.
