Special Council Meeting
Thursday, January 28, 2021

Present for Roll Call: Carlson, Djerf, Erickson, Jenich-Laplander, Salani, Schneiderhan (5:36pm), and Sullivan.

Guest: Edward Vertin.

The meeting was called to order in the village council chambers and the GoToMeeting website by President Sullivan at 5:30PM.

A motion was made by Erickson and seconded by Carlson to approve the **agenda** with the addition of two street items. Carried 6-0.

Erickson reported that Aspirus Keweenaw Hospital is interested in using the south 10' of Second Street between Osceola and Calumet Streets as a loading dock for the portable MRI. The street could still be one way going west.

The quotes for a new garbage truck & packer were received. Peterbilt quoted \$201,000 and Mack trucks \$221,000. Torch Lake Township is interested in our current garbage truck which could be sold for between \$135,000-\$150,000.

At 5:35PM, a motion was made by Erickson and seconded by Jenich-Laplander to enter **executive session** to discuss DPW union negotiations.

The meeting returned to regular session at 6:15PM.

Schneiderhan reported that the recreation committee will be meeting to work on a grant from Portage Health Foundation for playground equipment. The deadline to file is February 12, 2021.

The meeting adjourned at 6:20PM.
